

Session Objective

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to recognise the iPad camera app, understand basic device etiquette, identify physical buttons, take photos, and respond to notifications.

Understanding the Physical Device:

- Discuss iPad etiquette with students, ie. closing apps when asked, flipping the device upside down, locking the screen, and carrying appropriately when moving.
- Teach students how to wake / unlock the device using the Home Button or Swipe Up. Identify physical buttons (Home, Lock, Volume up/down) and practice
- unlocking and locking the device.
Introduce the concept of apps and demonstrate how to open the camera app
- (you can use the term "slide across app screens" for this).
Explain the purpose of the Live button (which will be covered in a later
- lesson).
Practice switching between front and back cameras.
Highlight the word "PHOTO" (in yellow) on the camera interface.

Taking Photos:

- Instruct students to take a photo (specify the colour) using the camera app.
- How to preview the captured photo.
- Taking more photos, utilising zoom
- colourful (use the phrase "crabby claw pinch fingers" to describe zooming gestures).

Notifications:

- Explain that if students see a notification (e.g., a permission request), they will likely need to tap "Allow."
**students are too often to 'act on the side of caution' and therefore tap 'Don't Allow'. This leads to issues with apps being unable to use features such as camera. Use iPad's Settings > Privacy & Security to correct wrongly tapped permissions.*
