

Session Objective

By the end of this lesson, students can take well-framed photos using the iPad camera app. They will understand proper positioning, framing techniques, and the importance of retaking photos when needed.



Review

Unlocking and Opening the Camera:

- Review how to unlock the iPad and open the camera app.
- Take a photo based on skills from previous learning
- Remind students about notifications by tapping "Allow" when prompted.



Learn

Taking Well-Framed Photos:

- Students learn how to take a quality photo:
 - ✓ Stand with feet firmly on the ground
 - ✓ Tuck arms in for stability
 - ✓ Position the object in the middle of the screen, leaving space between the object and edge of the photo..
- Discuss common issues (e.g., blurry photos, objects not in frame) and emphasise the importance of retaking when needed.
- Have students take three photos of each category:
 - Colour #1 / Colour #2 / Shape #1 / Shape #2
- Encourage creativity and exploration.



Review / Share

Sharing Favourites:

- Students choose their best or favourite photo.
- Arrange iPads for a classroom walkabout, where students can showcase their work.
